Connecting the Chromebook to Wi-Fi

When the Chromebook first turns on, if it is not connected to a wireless network, you should see the following screen prompting you to choose a network. Click the network you would like to connect to.

If you do not have wireless access in your house, you can review <u>this document</u> with some options that may be available to you.



Once you choose a network to connect to, if that network requires a password you will be prompted to enter a password. Enter the password and click Connect.
