


The District has installed 123 unit ventilators and 18 air handlers at the JB Kelly and Munoz-Marin schools in a total HVAC upgrade project. Workers also replaced over 2,000 feet of pipes throughout the JB Kelly and replaced ducts at Munoz-Marin to prevent moisture buildup and improve air quality.
