


Have proper staff coverage and clearly outlined and communicated roles and responsibilities.




Building Readiness

Schools are identified as "COVID Ready" in this graph when they meet all of the Health and Safety requirements in the graph to the left and they've received their ventilation assessment.



Train, inform, and otherwise prepare the District (students, staff, and families) for reopening.




