Swing Space Selection Criteria

Types of Facilities Considered for Swing Space:

- Vacant District buildings
- Underutilized District buildings
- Leasing commercial property
- Leasing college space
- Selective employment of modular units

How Swing Spaces are identified:

- Distance from current schools (regional geography)
- Amount of space available
- Separate entryways and exits
- Timely availability
- Usable square footage
- Life safety systems
- Environmental Quality
- Building systems conditions
- ADA access

- Transportation


Swing Space Regional Map
